Under the relevant legislation for *Workplace Injury Management*, employers are required to keep a Register of Injuries that is readily accessible in the workplace. The employer at any factory, workshop, office or shop is responsible for this register of injuries.

What is a Register of Injuries?

- The register is a current record of any injuries suffered by workers, whether they result in claims or not.
- Workers who enter particulars of any injury into the register, protect their right to make a claim.
- By prior arrangement, employers can use the register of injuries to notify their insurer of any workplace injuries.
