Food Safety Programs are compulsory for meat retailers in Victoria. The food safety audit is normally conducted to determine whether an effective Food Safety Program has been undertaken by the butcher. Food safety audits must be conducted by an approved food safety auditor.

Where you are cooking on the premises, or repackaging bulk ready-to-eat products, the required audit scope is higher – so costs more to deliver.

PrimeSafe is the governing body in Victoria that aims to ensure Food Safety standards are being met. PrimeSafe has responsibility for regulating the safety of meat, poultry and seafood in Victoria.
