4 Corners Report on Indonesian Cattle

The Australian Meat Industry Council (AMIC) does not ship live cattle to Indonesia.

- AMIC shares the abhorrence of the Australian Public with the animal cruelty shown on the 4 Corners Report on Monday night.
- AMIC has called for the immediate suspension of all live cattle shipments to Indonesia.

Before shipments of live cattle resume to Indonesia AMIC has called for:

- The Australian animal welfare standards to apply to Australian cattle in Indonesia.
- Only those processing plants which have undergone animal welfare training to be able to receive Australian cattle.
- That the system must be audited by an independent body.

Customers of AMIC Independent Local Butchers can be assured that the meat sold in their shops has been prepared by:

- A processing industry which is committed to the highest level of animal welfare.
- The processor operates under strict State and Federal animal welfare regulations.
- The process has properly trained employees who are competent in animal welfare.
